**ORDINANCE NO. CO-2016-18**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE III (ADMINISTRATION), SECTION 31.21 (BOARD OF FIRE AND POLICE COMMISSIONERS) OF THE MAYWOOD VILLAGE CODE RELATIVE TO THE COMPENSATION OF MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF FIRE AND POLICE COMMISSIONERS**

**WHEREAS**, Section 31.21 of the Maywood Village Code creates a Board of Fire and Police Commissioners ("BOFPC"); and

**WHEREAS**, Subsection 31.21(F) of the Maywood Village Code currently provides that the members of said Board shall receive compensation in the amount of \$100 for each meeting actually attended, up to a maximum of two meetings per month; and

**WHEREAS**, Subsection 31.21(F) further provides that the compensation of members of the BOFPC is subject to review and revision from time to time by the President and Board of Trustees; and

**WHEREAS**, the President and Board of Trustees have reviewed the compensation levels of BOFPC members and have determined that it is in the best interests of the Village to revise said subsection to increase the compensation of BOFPC members to \$150 per meeting.

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Maywood, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

**SECTION 1:** The above recitals are incorporated as if fully set forth herein as material terms and provisions.

**SECTION 2:** Title III (Administration), Section 31.21 (Board of Fire and Police Commissioners), subsection (F) (Compensation of Members) of the Maywood Village Code is amended to read in its entirety as follows:

(F) *Compensation of members.* Each member of the Board shall receive the sum of \$150 for each meeting actually attended, up to a maximum of \$300 per month, except the Secretary of the Board, who shall receive the sum of \$200 for each meeting actually attended, up to a maximum amount of \$400 per month. The compensation of members of the Board is subject to review and revision from time to time by the President and Board of Trustees.

**SECTION 3:** To the extent necessary, all table of contents, indexes, headings and internal references or cross-references to sections contained in the Maywood Village Code, as amended, that have been deleted or amended by the Code Amendments set forth above shall be amended by the Village's codifier so as to be consistent with the Code Amendments of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 4:** Each section, paragraph, clause and provision of this Ordinance is separable, and if any provision is held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision

shall not affect the remainder of this Ordinance, nor any part thereof, other than that part affected by such decision.

**SECTION 5:** All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance, to the extent of such conflict, are repealed. Except as to the Code Amendments set forth above in this Ordinance, all Chapters and Sections of the Maywood Village Code, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

**SECTION 6:** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.


