

ORDINANCE NO. CO-2013-02

**ORDINANCE REGULATING THE PARKING OF MOTOR VEHICLES AND
AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE PLACEMENT OF
MOTOR VEHICLE PARKING REGULATION SIGNS
IN THE VILLAGE OF MAYWOOD**

**(Two Hour Parking Signs: 19th Avenue Between St. Charles Road and Railroad Avenue
From 7:00 A.M to 6:00 P.M., Except Sundays and Holidays)**

WHEREAS, the Village of Maywood (the "Village") is a home rule municipality, having all of the powers and authority granted to such municipalities pursuant to Article VII, Section 6 of the Illinois Constitution of 1970, including the right to exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs; and

WHEREAS, Section 11-303 of the Illinois Vehicle Code (625 ILCS 5/11-303) authorize municipalities to place and maintain traffic-control devices, including traffic regulation signs and parking signs, upon highways under their maintenance jurisdiction as required to indicate and carry out the provisions of local traffic ordinances; and

WHEREAS, the Village President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Maywood have determined that the regulation of certain motor vehicle parking on certain streets and avenues in the Village, as set forth below in this Ordinance, are necessary and in the best interests of the Village, its residents, property owners, business owners and the public in order to enhance the commercial and residential uses and enjoyment of those areas; and

WHEREAS, the Village President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Maywood find that it is in the best interests of the health, welfare and safety of the Village, its residents, property owners, business owners and the public to amend the motor vehicle parking regulations within the Village at certain locations and to place signs in specific locations to regulate such on-street parking as set forth below in this Ordinance.

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF
THE VILLAGE OF MAYWOOD, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:**

SECTION 1: Each whereas paragraph set forth above is incorporated by reference into this Section 1.

SECTION 2: The Village President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Maywood authorize the placement of the following traffic signs, and direct Village Staff to place as many signs as reasonably necessary, to advise the public of the enforcement of the following traffic regulations:

"Two Hour Parking Only, Except Sundays and Holidays" signs at the following locations:

- East and West Sides of 19th Avenue Between the North Right of Way Line of St. Charles Road and the South Right of Way Line of Railroad Avenue From 7:00 A.M to 6:00 P.M

SECTION 3: All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance, to the extent of such conflict, are repealed.

SECTION 4: Each section, paragraph, clause and provision of this Ordinance is separable, and if any provision is held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the remainder of this Ordinance, nor any part thereof, other than that part affected by such decision.

SECTION 5: Except as to the provisions set forth above in this Ordinance, all Chapters and Sections of the Maywood Municipal Code shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 6: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.






