ORDINANCE NO. CO-2013-25

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE VII (TRAFFIC CODE), CHAPTER 72 (STOPPING, STANDING AND PARKING), SECTION 72.34 (OVERNIGHT PARKING PERMITS) OF THE MAYWOOD VILLAGE CODE REGARDING OVERNIGHT PARKING PERMITS ON 5TH AVENUE

WHEREAS, the Village of Maywood is a home rule unit pursuant to the provisions Article VII, Section 6(a) of the Illinois Constitution of 1970; and

WHEREAS, Section 72.34 of the Village Code regulates overnight parking permits within the Village of Maywood; and

WHEREAS, the Village has prohibited overnight parking on certain streets within the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Village has received a request from certain property owners located on the 2100 block of 5th Avenue requesting the ability to obtain overnight parking permits on 5th Avenue from Roosevelt Road to Filmore Avenue for the safety and convenience of their residents; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Maywood have determined that it is in the best interests of the health, welfare, and safety of the residents of this Village to amend Section 72.34 relative to overnight parking permits to allow overnight parking on a certain portion of 5th Avenue, as set forth below.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF MAYWOOD, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: That the findings set forth above are incorporated by reference into this Section 1 as if fully recited herein.

SECTION 2: That Subsection 72.34(J) of Section 72.34 (Overnight Parking Permits), Chapter 72 (Stopping, Standing and Parking), Title VII (Traffic Code) of the Maywood Village Code, as amended, shall be further amended to read in its entirety as follows:

"§ 72.34. OVERNIGHT PARKING PERMITS.

- (J) **DESIGNATED AREAS AND PROHIBITED AREAS.** The Finance Director, or his or her designee, may approve an application for an overnight parking permit as provided in this Section for use on any street in the Village, except that no overnight parking permit shall be issued for use on the following streets:

1. 1st Avenue (Entire Village)
2. 5th Avenue (Entire Village, except from Roosevelt Road to Filmore Avenue)
3. 9th Avenue (Entire Village)
4. 17th Avenue (from 1000 S. to Village Limits)
5. 19th Avenue (from 100 S. to 1000 S.)
6. Chicago Avenue (Entire Village)
7. Lake Street (Entire Village)
8. St. Charles Road (Entire Village)
9. Washington Blvd. (Entire Village)
10. Madison Avenue (Entire Village)
11. Harrison Avenue (Entire Village)
12. Bataan Avenue (Entire Village)
13. Roosevelt Road (Entire Village)"

SECTION 3: That nothing in this Ordinance hereby adopted shall be construed to affect any suit or proceeding pending in any court, or any rights acquired, or liability incurred, or any cause or causes of action acquired or existing, under any act or ordinance hereby repealed as cited in this Ordinance; nor shall any just or legal right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired, or affected by this Ordinance.

SECTION 4: That all ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance, to the extent of such conflict, are repealed.

SECTION 5: That each section, paragraph, clause and provision of this Ordinance is separable and if any provision is held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the remainder of this Ordinance, nor any part thereof, other than that part affected by such decision.

SECTION 6: That except as to the Code amendments set forth above in this Ordinance, all Chapters and Sections of the Maywood Village Code, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 7: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption, approval and publication in pamphlet form as required by law.
