ORDINANCE NO. CO-2016-08

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE III (ADMINISTRATION), CHAPTER 30 (VILLAGE ADMINISTRATION), SECTION 30.14 (INDEPENDENT INSPECTOR GENERAL), SUBSECTION 30.14(B) (DESIGNATION OF COOK COUNTY SHERIFF) OF THE MAYWOOD VILLAGE CODE IN REGARD TO DESIGNATION OF THE COOK COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE TO HOLD THE OFFICE OF INDEPENDENT INSPECTOR GENERAL

WHEREAS, it is imperative that the residents of the Village trust and have confidence in the integrity of their elected and appointed officials, as well as the employees of the Village; and

WHEREAS, in 2013, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Maywood determined that in order to promote honest and effective government, it was appropriate that the Village establish an independent office to whom the people of this Village can turn to for assistance in eliminating both the fact of and the appearance of fraud, corruption, and unethical activities in Village government. In 2013, the Cook County Sheriff's Office offered to serve the Village, without charge, in the capacity of an independent Inspector General for the Village of Maywood; and

WHEREAS, with the adoption of Ordinance No. CO-2013-41 on July 16, 2013, the President and Board of Trustees amended the Maywood Village Code ("MVC") to establish the Office of Independent Inspector General and authorized the Cook County Sheriff's Office to hold that Office to assist the Village's corporate authorities, the Village Manager, the Village staff, the Village Attorney and the Village residents in promoting honesty, transparency, ethical responsibility and fiscal responsibility in the Village government; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Maywood desire to amend the MVC to maintain the Office of Independent Inspector General and designate the Cook County Sheriff's Office to hold that Office (the "Code Amendments"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the powers and authority granted to the Village by the applicable state laws, including the police powers and code enforcement provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/1-2, 5/1-2-1.1 and 5/11-1 *et seq.*) and its home rule authority under Article VII, Section 6 of the Illinois Constitution of 1970, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Maywood find that the below Code Amendments further the public health, welfare and safety, and are in the best interests of the Village, its residents and the public.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF MAYWOOD, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Each Whereas paragraph set forth above is incorporated by reference into this Section 1.

SECTION 2: Title III (Administration), Chapter 30 (Village Administration), Section 30.14 (Independent Inspector General), Subsection 30.14(B) (Designation of Cook County Sheriff) of the Maywood Village Code shall be amended to read in its entirety as follows:

(B) Designation of Cook County Sheriff. The Office of the Cook County Sheriff is designated to serve as the Independent Inspector General ("OIG"). The Office of the Cook County Sheriff shall serve as the OIG for the Village until such time as

either party provides the other party with written notice that terminates this arrangement. The Village may terminate this designation by written notice approved by a majority vote of the corporate authorities of the Village or by the adoption of an ordinance that repeals this Section of the Maywood Village Code.. The OIG shall serve without compensation.

SECTION 3: To the extent necessary, all tables of contents, indexes, headings, and internal references or cross-references to sections that need to be amended or deleted within the Maywood Code of Ordinances, as amended, as a consequence of the above Code Amendments, shall be amended by the Village's codifier so as to be consistent with the terms of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4: All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance, to the extent of such conflict, are repealed.

SECTION 5: Each section, paragraph, clause and provision of this Ordinance is separable, and if any provision is held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the remainder of this Ordinance, nor any part thereof, other than that part affected by such decision.

SECTION 6: Except as to the Code amendments set forth above in this Ordinance, all Chapters and Sections of the Maywood Village Code, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 7: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption, approval, and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.




