ORDINANCE CREATING A NEW SCHEDULE VII IN CHAPTER 76 (PARKING SCHEDULES) OF THE MAYWOOD VILLAGE CODE RELATIVE TO DESIGNATED HANDICAPPED PARKING SPACES AND DIRECTING THE PLACEMENT OF A MOTOR VEHICLE PARKING REGULATION SIGN IN THE VILLAGE OF MAYWOOD

(Designated Handicapped Parking: 1517 South 4th Avenue, Maywood)

WHEREAS, the Village of Maywood (the "Village") is a home rule municipality, having all of the powers and authority granted to such municipalities pursuant to Article VII, Section 6 of the Illinois Constitution of 1970, including the right to exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs; and

WHEREAS, Section 11-303 of the Illinois Vehicle Code (625 ILCS 5/11-303) authorizes municipalities to place and maintain traffic-control devices, including traffic regulation signs and parking signs, upon highways under their maintenance jurisdiction as required to indicate and carry out the provisions of local traffic ordinances; and

WHEREAS, Section 72.33 of the Village Code permits a resident who has been determined to be handicapped in accordance with Illinois law to request the designation of a handicapped parking spot on the street adjacent to their residence; and

WHEREAS, an application for designation of a handicapped parking spot was submitted by Claria G. Searcy and Sandra L. McIntosh for the address 1517 South 4th Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the Traffic and Safety Commission reviewed and recommended the approval of the requested handicap designation on May 5th, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the Village President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Maywood find that it is in the best interests of the health, welfare and safety of the Village, its residents, property owners, business owners and the public to amend the motor vehicle parking regulations within the Village to add a Schedule VII regarding handicapped parking location and to authorize a handicapped parking space at 1517 South 4th Avenue, Maywood.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF MAYWOOD, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Each whereas paragraph set forth above is incorporated by reference into this Section 1.

SECTION 2: Chapter 76 (Parking Schedules) of the Maywood Village Code, is amended to create a new Schedule VII (Handicapped Parking Spots and Zones) and to add a designated handicapped parking spot at 1517 South 4th Avenue, Maywood, to read in its entirety as follows:

"Schedule VII. Handicapped Parking Spots and Zones

The corporate authorities hereby authorize the placement of handicapped parking signs at the following locations and hereby direct the Village staff to place signs necessary for the designation of such locations:

Street	Side	Location
4 th Ave	East	1517 South 4 th Avenue, Maywood, Illinois 60153

SECTION 3: All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance, to the extent of such conflict, are repealed.

SECTION 4: Each section, paragraph, clause and provision of this Ordinance is separable, and if any provision is held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the remainder of this Ordinance, nor any part thereof, other than that part affected by such decision.

SECTION 5: Except as to the provisions set forth above in this Ordinance, all Chapters and Sections of the Maywood Municipal Code shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 6: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.


