ORDINANCE NO. CO-2014-35

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 95.03
(RETAIL FOOD ESTABLISHMENT SANITATION REGULATIONS)
OF CHAPTER 95 (FOOD SERVICE ESTABLISHMENTS)
OF TITLE IX (GENERAL REGULATIONS)
OF THE MAYWOOD VILLAGE CODE RELATIVE TO
FOOD SERVICE ESTABLISHMENT HEALTH INSPECTION FEES**

WHEREAS, the Village of Maywood (the "Village") is a home rule municipality, having all of the powers and authority granted to such municipalities pursuant to Article VII, Section 6 of the Illinois Constitution of 1970, including the right to exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Maywood find that it is necessary to increase certain inspection fees in order to offset increased costs that are charged by the Cook County Department of Public Health, who performs health inspection services on behalf of the Village in regard to businesses located in the Village pursuant to an intergovernmental agreement entered into by the Village and the Cook County Department of Public Health.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF MAYWOOD, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Each whereas paragraph set forth above is incorporated by reference into this Section 1.

SECTION 2: Subsection 95.03(L) (Retail Food Establishment Sanitation Regulations; Inspection Frequency and Cost) of Chapter 95 (Food Service Establishments) of Title IX (General Regulations) of the Maywood Village Code is amended to read in its entirety as follows:

"(L) Inspection frequency and cost. An inspection of a food establishment shall be performed at least once every six (6) months. The cost of such inspections shall be \$130.00 per inspection and \$260.00 per year for two (2) inspections. Additional inspections of the food establishments shall be performed as often as necessary for the enforcement of this section and will be charged at the above per inspection rate."

SECTION 3: All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance, to the extent of such conflict, are repealed.

SECTION 4: Each section, paragraph, clause and provision of this Ordinance is severable, and if any provision is held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such

decision shall not affect the remainder of this Ordinance, nor any part thereof, other than that part affected by such decision.

SECTION 5: Except as to the Code amendments set forth above in this Ordinance, all Chapters and Sections of the Maywood Village Code, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 6: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage, approval and publication as required by law.
