

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WHEREAS, the Village of Maywood is a home rule unit pursuant to the provisions of Article VII, Section 6(a) of the Illinois Constitution of 1970; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Maywood is authorized to adopt codes by reference pursuant to Section 1-3-2 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/1-3-2); and

WHEREAS, Section 150.065 of the Maywood Village Code currently sets forth various regulations and standards pertaining to plumbing and the performance of plumbing work within the Village, as well as the Village's prior adoption of the Illinois Plumbing Code/1993 and modifications to same; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the authority provided by Section 1-3-2 of the Illinois Municipal Code, and its home rule powers, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Maywood have determined that it is in the best interests of the health, welfare, and safety of the residents of this Village to adopt the Illinois Plumbing Code/2004, as published by the Illinois Department of Public Health at 77 Ill. Admin. Code 890, as the Plumbing Code of the Village; and

WHEREAS, the President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Maywood have determined that the Illinois Plumbing Code/2004, which is the most current version of the Illinois Plumbing Code, best regulates and governs the plumbing standards to be maintained on all property, buildings and structures within the Village and to aid in ensuring that plumbing facilities and the water they provide are safe, sanitary and fit for occupation and use; and

WHEREAS, adoption of the Illinois Plumbing Code/2004 without modification, will cause the current restrictions on approved materials for water distribution and water service pipes within the Village to be deleted, allowing use of a wider variety of approved materials for water distribution and water service pipes within the Village, thereby benefitting residents and business owners who are frequent targets of theft due to the previous emphasis on use of copper piping within the Village; and

WHEREAS, a copy of this Ordinance has been on file with the Office of the Village Clerk for at least thirty (30) days prior to the approval date of this Ordinance and has, during that time, been available for public use, inspection, and examination. In addition, pursuant to Public Act 92-489, the Village notified the Illinois Building

Commission of these proposed Code amendments at least thirty (30) days prior to the approval date of this Ordinance.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF MAYWOOD, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: The findings set forth above are incorporated by reference into this Section 1 as if fully recited herein.

SECTION 2: Section 150.065 of the Maywood Village Code is amended to read in its entirety as follows:

"§ 150.065 ILLINOIS PLUMBING CODE ADOPTED.

(A) (1) The Village does adopt as the Plumbing Code of the Village the language and terms of the Illinois Plumbing Code/~~4993~~2004, 77 Ill. Admin. Code 890, published by the Illinois Department of Public Health, a copy of which is made a part hereof by reference.

(2) One copy of the Illinois Plumbing Code/~~4993~~2004 shall be kept on file in the office of the Director of Community Development, the Village Clerk's office and the Maywood Public Library.

~~(B) The Illinois Plumbing Code/49932004 adopted by reference pursuant to this section is amended as it applies within the Village as follows:~~

~~(1) Appendix A, Table A entitled "Approved Materials for Water Service Pipe" is amended by deleting the following sections: Acrylonitrile Butadiene Styrene (ABS) Pipe, 4) Chlorinated Polyvinyl Chloride (CPVC) Pipe, 8) Poly butylene (PB) Pipe, 9) Polyethylene (PE) Pipe, 10) Polyethylene (PE) Tubing, and (11) Polyvinyl Chloride (PVC) Pipe.~~

~~(2) Appendix A, Table A entitled "Approved Materials for Water Distribution Pipe" is hereby amended by deleting the following sections: 2) Chlorinated Polyvinyl Chloride (CPVC) Pipe/Tubing, 5) Cross Linked Polyethylene, and 7) Poly Butylene (PB) Pipe/Tubing.~~

SECTION 3: All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance, to the extent of such conflict, are repealed.

SECTION 4: Each section, paragraph, clause and provision of this Ordinance is separable and if any provision is held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the remainder of this Ordinance, nor any part thereof, other than that part affected by such decision.

SECTION 5: Except as to the Code amendments set forth above in this Ordinance, all Chapters and Sections of the Maywood Village Code, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 6: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect on May 1, 2013, following its passage, approval and publication as required by law.


