

ORDINANCE NO. 2018-08

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CREATION AND RATIFICATION OF THE ISSUANCE OF
A CLASS "C" LIQUOR LICENSE (TEMPORARY SPECIAL EVENT LIQUOR LICENSE FOR
NON-VILLAGE OWNED PROPERTY) FOR ST. EULALIA CHURCH LOCATED AT 1845 SOUTH 9TH AVENUE
(Special Event Date: February 3, 2018)**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF
MAYWOOD, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:**

SECTION 1: Pursuant to Chapter 117, Section 117.23(C) of the Maywood Village Code, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Maywood authorize the creation of a Class "C" Liquor License in order to allow the Local Liquor Control Commissioner, in his/her discretion, to issue the Class "C" Liquor License to St. Eulalia Church ("Applicant") for purposes of allowing the Applicant to conduct a special event at the property located at 1845 South 9th Avenue, Maywood, Illinois on February 3, 2018 (or such other alternate date, as determined by the Local Liquor Control Commissioner) ("Special Event"). St. Eulalia Church is the owner of the 1845 South 9th Avenue property.

SECTION 2: The issuance of a Class "C" Liquor License for the Special Event to the Applicant by the Local Liquor Control Commissioner is subject to compliance with the following conditions:

- A. The Class "C" Liquor License is only valid on February 3, 2018 for the Special Event, or one (1) alternate calendar day in 2018, as approved by the Local Liquor Control Commissioner.
- B. The Applicant shall comply with the applicable provisions of Chapter 117 (Liquor) of the Maywood Village Code, including the Dram Shop Insurance requirement, as well as the other applicable provisions of State law and the Maywood Village Code, including but not limited to the Fire Prevention Code, the Plumbing Code, the Building Code, the Property Maintenance Code, the Illinois Accessibility Code and the Zoning Code.
- C. All persons who sell or serve alcoholic liquor or handle alcoholic liquor on the licensed premises shall take and successfully complete a Beverage Alcohol Sellers and Servers Education and Training (BASSET) Program that has been certified by the State of Illinois. A copy of the BASSET course completion certificate(s) for each such person shall be made available at all times at the licensed premises for inspection by the Local Liquor Control Commissioner, or his or her designee.
- D. Service and consumption of alcoholic beverages at the Special Event shall be allowed inside the building located at the 1845 South 9th Avenue property and shall be permitted only from 6:00 p.m. to 11:59 p.m. on February 3, 2018. It shall be illegal to serve or consume alcoholic beverages in violation of the provisions set forth in this Ordinance.
- E. If the Class "C" Liquor License is issued to the Applicant, the Class "C" Liquor License may be revoked immediately by the Local Liquor Control Commissioner in the event of a violation of the Maywood Liquor Code regulations or any of the provisions of this Ordinance by the Applicant or any of its employees, representatives, agents, guests or contractual service providers.

- F. The Village reserves the right to charge St. Eulalia for special municipal services, such as police, fire and public works personnel and services that are necessary to protect the health, welfare and safety of the public and those individuals who attend the Special Event. By accepting the issuance of the Class "C" Liquor License, St. Eulalia agrees to pay for such special municipal services provided by the Village, which are necessary to protect the health, welfare and safety of the public and those individuals who attend the Special Event. The charges for such special municipal services, if provided, will be based on the actual out-of-pocket costs incurred by the Village.

SECTION 3: All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance, to the extent of such conflict, are repealed.

SECTION 4: Each section, paragraph, clause and provision of this Ordinance is separable, and if any provision is held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the remainder of this Ordinance, nor any part thereof, other than that part affected by such decision.

SECTION 5: Except as to the Code amendments set forth above in this Ordinance, all Chapters and Sections of the Maywood Village Code, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 6: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption, approval and publication in the manner provided by law.
