

RESOLUTION NO. 2017- 51

**A RESOLUTION REQUESTING RECLASSIFICATION OF
17TH AVENUE AND 19TH AVENUE IN THE VILLAGE OF MAYWOOD, ILLINOIS
BY THE NORTH CENTRAL COUNCIL OF MAYORS**

WHEREAS, the North Central Council of Mayors (“Council”) has been designated the appropriate local official as defined in the Federal Highway Acts of 1970, 1973, and 1976 and the Surface Transportation Acts of 1979, 1982, 1986, 1991, 1997, and 2005 to select routes and project for improvement on the Federal Classification System and on Surface Transportation Program (“STP”) eligible routes; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Maywood is under the jurisdiction of the North Central Council of Mayors; and

WHEREAS, 17th Avenue from Madison Street to Washington Boulevard is currently classified as a Collector Route; however, this roadway does not serve in such a capacity at this time and the classification is not practical. Therefore, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Maywood desire that 17th Avenue from Madison Street to Washington Boulevard be removed from the Functional Classification List; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Maywood desire the reclassification of 19th Avenue from Madison Street to St. Charles Road in the Village of Maywood as a Collector Route in the Functional Classification System and that such portion of roadway be listed on the Functional Classification System List; and

WHEREAS, 19th Avenue from Madison Street to St. Charles Road serves as a Collector Route for residential and commercial traffic and other motorists who travel in motor vehicles on this route within the Village of Maywood; and

WHEREAS, 19th Avenue from Madison Street to St. Charles Road is a connector route to the high volume routes of Madison Street and St. Charles Road and many motor vehicles utilize this segment of roadway; and

WHEREAS, by applying to the Council for reclassification of this particular roadway, the Village of Maywood would be eligible to receive federal funding for future roadway improvements for this roadway; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Maywood find it to be in the best interests of the Village and its residents to request the consideration of the reclassification of both above-described roadways by the Council.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF MAYWOOD, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Each Whereas paragraph above is incorporated by reference into this Section 1 and made a part hereof as material and operative provisions of this Resolution.

SECTION 2: The President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Maywood request that the North Central Council of Mayors remove 17th Avenue from Madison Street to Washington Boulevard from the Functional Classification List and reclassify 19th Avenue from Madison Street to St. Charles Road in the Village of Maywood as a Collector Route in the Functional Classification System and that such portion of roadway be listed on the Functional Classification System List.
