

ORDINANCE NO. CO-2018-14

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DISPOSAL OF SURPLUS
PERSONAL PROPERTY OWNED BY THE VILLAGE OF MAYWOOD**

(Maywood Fire Department 2002 Ford E-450 Ambulance)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 11-76-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/11-76-4), the Village President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Maywood (the "Corporate Authorities") may dispose of personal property owned by the Village when, in the opinion of a majority of the Corporate Authorities, such property is no longer necessary, useful to, or for the best interests of the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Maywood Fire Chief has requested that certain surplus personal property owned by the Village, as described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof, be disposed of pursuant to State law because it is no longer necessary, useful or in the best interests of the Village to retain the surplus personal property; and

WHEREAS, the Village President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Maywood, Cook County, Illinois, deem it no longer necessary, useful or in the best interests of the Village to retain the surplus personal property described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof, and desire that the Village Manager dispose of such property in any lawful manner.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF MAYWOOD, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: The Village President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Maywood find and declare that all itemized property of the Village set forth in Exhibit "A", which is attached hereto and made a part hereof, is surplus personal property because it is no longer necessary, useful or in the best interests of the Village to retain such property. The Village Manager, or his designee, is authorized to dispose of the personal surplus property of the Village set forth in Exhibit "A" in any lawful manner.
