**ORDINANCE AMENDING
SCHEDULE VII (HANDICAPPED PARKING SPOTS AND ZONES),
CHAPTER 76 (PARKING SCHEDULES) OF THE MAYWOOD VILLAGE CODE
RELATIVE TO DESIGNATED HANDICAPPED PARKING SPACES AND
DIRECTING THE PLACEMENT OF MOTOR VEHICLE PARKING REGULATION SIGNS**

**(Designated Handicapped Parking Area:
East and West Sides of Public Right-of-Way Adjacent to and Opposite of
the 1008 South 17th Avenue Property)**

WHEREAS, the Village of Maywood (the "Village") is a home rule municipality, having all of the powers and authority granted to such municipalities pursuant to Article VII, Section 6 of the Illinois Constitution of 1970, including the right to exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs; and

WHEREAS, Section 11-303 of the Illinois Vehicle Code (625 ILCS 5/11-303) authorizes municipalities to place and maintain traffic-control devices, including traffic regulation signs and parking signs, upon highways under their maintenance jurisdiction as required to indicate and carry out the provisions of local traffic ordinances; and

WHEREAS, the Traffic and Safety Commission has received multiple requests for the installation of handicapped parking signs in front of and opposite of Kathy's Kitchen Restaurant located at the 1008 South 17th Avenue property, which is the east side and west side of the public rights-of-way adjacent to and directly opposite from the 1008 South 17th Avenue property (the "Handicapped Parking Area"); and

WHEREAS, the Traffic and Safety Commission has reviewed and unanimously recommended amendment of the Village Code to create the requested Handicapped Parking Location and approval of the installation of handicapped signage at the Handicapped Parking Area; and

WHEREAS, the Village President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Maywood find that it is in the best interests of the health, welfare and safety of the Village, its residents, property owners, business owners and the public to amend Schedule VII (Handicapped Parking Spots and Zones) of Chapter 76 (Parking Schedules) of the Maywood Village Code to create the proposed Handicapped Parking Area and to install handicapped parking signs on the east side and west side of the public rights-of-way adjacent to and directly opposite from the 1008 South 17th Avenue property.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF MAYWOOD, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Each whereas paragraph set forth above is incorporated by reference into this Section 1.

SECTION 2: Schedule VII (Handicapped Parking Spots and Zones) of Chapter 76 (Parking Schedules) of the Maywood Village Code is amended to create a handicapped parking area on the east side and west side of the public rights-of-way adjacent to and directly opposite from the 1008 South 17th Avenue property, and to authorize the installation of the necessary handicapped parking signs at the Handicapped Parking Area, and shall read in its entirety as follows:

Schedule VII. Handicapped Parking Spots and Zones

The Village President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Maywood authorize the placement of handicapped parking signs at the following locations and direct the Village staff to place signs necessary for the designation of such locations:

Street	Side	Location
4 th Ave	East	1517 South 4 th Avenue
17 th Ave	West	1008 South 17 th Avenue
17 th Ave	East	Opposite side of public right-of-way from 1008 South 17 th Avenue

SECTION 3: All tables of contents, indexes and internal references or cross-references to sections that need to be amended or deleted as a consequence of the above Code Amendments shall be amended by the Village’s codifier so as to be consistent with the terms of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4: All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance, to the extent of such conflict, are repealed.

SECTION 5: Each section, paragraph, clause and provision of this Ordinance is separable, and if any provision is held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the remainder of this Ordinance, nor any part thereof, other than that part affected by such decision.

SECTION 6: Except as to the Code amendments set forth above in this Ordinance, all Chapters and Sections of the Maywood Village Code, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 7: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption, approval and publication in the manner provided by law.

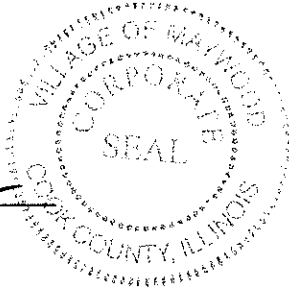
