

ORDINANCE NO. CO-2021-26

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 76 (PARKING SCHEDULES) OF
TITLE VII (TRAFFIC CODE), INCLUDING SUBSECTION A (NO PARKING AT ANY TIME) OF
SCHEDULE III (NO PARKING ZONES) OF THE MAYWOOD VILLAGE CODE
(Parking Signs Authorized: No Parking Signs at 20th Avenue and Madison Street Intersection)**

WHEREAS, the Village of Maywood (the "Village") is a home rule unit pursuant to the provisions of Article VII, Section 6(a) of the Illinois Constitution of 1970, including the right to exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs; and

WHEREAS, Section 11-1-1 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/11-1-1) grants to municipalities the authority to pass and enforce all necessary police ordinances. Section 11-80-2 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/11-80-2) grants municipalities the authority to regulate the use of streets within the Village. Section 11-208 of the Illinois Vehicle Code (625 ILCS 5/11-208) authorizes local authorities within the State to restrict the use of highways as authorized in Chapter 15 of the Vehicle Code; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Maywood desire to make certain amendments to Subsection A (No Parking At Any Time) of Schedule III (No Parking Zones) of Chapter 76 (Parking Schedules) of Title 7 (Traffic) of the Maywood Village Code concerning the adoption, posting and enforcement of certain on-street parking regulations at the 20th Avenue and Madison Street intersection to enhance vehicle driver and pedestrian safety by reducing the sight-line visibility issues at 20th Avenue and Madison Street due to existing on-street parking of vehicles immediately adjacent to and abutting the intersection (the "Code Amendments") as follows:

- A. No Parking from Sign to the Corner: Sign posted on the North Side of Madison Street, 53.00 Feet West of the West Line of 20th Avenue.
- B. No Parking from Sign to the Corner: Sign posted on the North Side of Madison Street, 115.00 Feet East of the East Line of 20th Avenue.

; and

WHEREAS, as a home rule unit of local government, the Village may regulate property and property owners located within the corporate boundaries of the Village; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to its home rule authority granted under Article VII, Section 6 of the Illinois Constitution of 1970, and the authority granted under the applicable provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/) and the Illinois Vehicle Code (625 ILCS 5/15), the Village President and Board of Trustees find that adopting the Code Amendments set forth below is in the best interests of the Village, the Village residents, business owners, property owners and the public.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF MAYWOOD, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Each Whereas paragraph set forth above is incorporated by reference into this Section 1.

SECTION 2: Subsection A (No Parking At Any Time) of Schedule III (No Parking Zones) of Chapter 76 (Parking Schedules) of Title VII (Traffic Code) of the Maywood Village Code is amended to add the following

regulations in their appropriate place within the existing Chart as follows (new text is marked with underlining; deletions to existing text marked using strikethrough):

<u>STREET</u>	<u>SIDE</u>	<u>LOCATION</u>
<u>Madison Street</u>	<u>North</u>	<u>From West Side of 20th Avenue, 53.00 Feet West of the West Line of 20th Avenue</u>
<u>Madison Street</u>	<u>North</u>	<u>From East Side of 20th Avenue, 115.00 Feet East of the East Line of 20th Avenue</u>

SECTION 3: To the extent necessary, all tables of contents, indexes, headings, and internal references or cross-references to sections that need to be amended or deleted within the Maywood Code of Ordinances, as amended, as a consequence of the above Code Amendments, shall be amended by the Village’s codifier so as to be consistent with the terms of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4: All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance, to the extent of such conflict, are repealed.

SECTION 5: Each section, paragraph, clause and provision of this Ordinance is severable and, if any provision is held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the remainder of this Ordinance, nor any part thereof, other than that part affected by such decision.

SECTION 6: Except as to the Code amendments set forth above in this Ordinance, all Chapters and Sections of the Maywood Village Code, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 7: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage, approval and publication as required by law.
